- Cutting will be Friday, March 29. Check-In will be at 8:00-8:45a.m., cutting starts at 9:00a.m.
- Queen contest will be held after cutting on Friday, starting at 3:00.
- The 1st round of HS roughstock and 1st round of HS barrels will be run on Friday night. Check in 4:45-5:45pm. Rodeo will start at 6:00 pm.
- Please check D4 website for updates. Order of events will be posted after March 25.
- Check-In on Saturday, March 30 will be 7:00-7:45 with rodeo beginning at 8:00 am.
- JH will be run on one day only. No JH on Sunday.
- Sunday rodeo will start at 8:00 am.

Garcia Spurs to All-Around winners in HS and JH. Buckles to event average winners in HS and JH. Jackpot money will be paid on the average.

Online Entries: An online entry is open and available now. Please use the link sent to you or go to the D4 webpage for the link. You will be able to order stalls and camping on the online entry as well. **Please read all directions carefully. If you forget to order a stall, camping, etc., you will be charged the office/ambulance fees again to go back in which are non-refundable.** Please be sure to enter/purchase everything on your first entry. **Entries close March 11, 2019 at 8:00 pm. There will be a two day late window open until March 13, 8:00 pm with a \$100 late fee.**

Please be aware, payment will be withdrawn immediately upon entry. If you have insufficient funds, the payment will not go through and contestant will not be entered. After receiving your confirmation number, please click "print receipt" and this will also email you a receipt.

School Verification/Medical Release: The grade verification form and the Salinas Valley Fairgrounds waiver are also attached to this email. These must be signed, stamped, and **postmarked by March 13, 2019.** Please mail to: CHSRA D4 attn: Nikki Bell, 1638 Thomas Rd., Hollister, CA 95023. (If you have already filled out a SVF waiver this year, you do not need to do another.)

Set Ups: If requesting a set up, it must be mailed with your grade verification to CHSRA D4, 1638 Thomas Rd., Hollister, CA 95023 **and be postmarked by March 13, 2019.** (There will be no set ups for rough stock, cutting, or JH events).

Stalls/Camping: There are stalls and camping available to order on the online entry for Friday through Sunday. **Pens must be cleaned out before you leave or you will be charged a \$50 fee/stall.** If you need a stall/camping for Thursday night, the fairground is charging \$30/stall and \$35 for camping. You will pay this at the rodeo to Marietta Carlin. If you have any questions about stalls/camping, please contact Marietta at 831-512-8787. Unfortunately, tie-ups and portable pens are not allowed at this rodeo because of abuse of the privilege at a rodeo last year. The fairgrounds will not allow them anymore. Please remember to clean around your trailer area, we want to leave the fairgrounds as clean as when we came in.

Queen Contest: We will be hosting the queen contest for D4, D5, and D6. We will run the queen contest after the cutting on Friday. We will start at 3:00.

Volleyball/Kickball Game Saturday after the rodeo! Bring your tennis shoes and volleyball and kickball skills!!! We will be having volleyball and kickball games in the arena after the rodeo on Saturday evening!! Be ready to play!!!

Entries Close March 11, 2019 at 8:00. There will be a 2 day late entry window open until 8:00 pm on March 13, with a late fee of \$100. Entries will be closed after 8:00 pm on March 13.
